

LETTERBOXING INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARK #6

There are two ways to access the letterbox at Park #6. You can either take the route that is a longer hike or the route that is a longer drive. Remember to bring your scorecard with you to this self-guided park, and once you find the letterbox, stamp the designated section of your card.

LONGER HIKE:

Once you have determined the location of this park, head to the venue's main parking lot.

From there, take either the red marked trail (about 1.4 miles one way) or the blue marked trail (about 1.7 miles one way) to the historic "den" where the letterbox is located. Trail maps are available at the park and on the DEP Web site.

LONGER DRIVE:

Head to the parking lot for the historic "den," which is about 1.3 miles away from the park's main parking lot. Note: the lot is off Wolf Den Road. You will need to drive slowly and carefully on this gravel road for about half a mile.

Then, hike about one quarter mile (one way) to the historic "den" where the letterbox is located. Please be aware that unlike the park's main entrance, this entrance does not provide access to drinking water so be sure to bring your water bottles!
